Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever and ever.

Consider your personal sins. In your mind name them specifically. Now pray Romans 5:8, "But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

Now praise God. His love covers us our actions yesterday, today, tomorrow!

3. Chandler Focus: Our efforts can seem feeble ("a fox would break down their wall of stones", v3). Do you feel like the church, Chandler, is making a difference in society?




Divide into pairs and pray over each other...
